AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The grouse made in this petition is against the orders passed by the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana delegating the powers of the Appellate Authority/PIO/APIO to the officers other than those designated by the Government.

Learned counsel states that in this regard the petitioner has moved a representation dated 10.07.2013 (Annexure P-8). He further states that at this stage he would be satisfied if in the first instance a direction is issued to the respondent No.1 to consider the said representation and decide the same expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.1 is directed to consider the said representation and decide the same by passing necessary order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
